- B. The policy of University Place School District established the following criteria as the basis for approving or denying transfer requests from non-resident students:
1. The student applied for admission within the time limit established by the district;
 2. Adequate space and an appropriate program are available, as determined by the district, at the grade level or program in the school the student requests to attend;
 3. The District reserves the right to rescind an entrance release to a non-resident student in the event the student is not profiting from the placement, the circumstances under which the entrance was approved have changed significantly, or the student becomes eligible for special education or other special programs;
 4. The student has not been expelled or suspended from a public school for more than ten consecutive days within the last school year;
 5. Acceptance of the student will not result in a hardship for the receiving district;
 6. The student's attendance is in compliance with University Place School District's standards.
- C. Transportation to and from University Place School District #83 is the parent's responsibility.
- D. In compliance with RCW 28A.225.280, eligibility of transfer students for participation in extracurricular activities shall be subject to rules adopted by WIAA.
