Nomination/Assessment Process Checklist
Student Currently Attends or Resides in UPSD
Spring 2008

- Student currently attends school or resides in UPSD (student resides in the University Place School District OR is attending on a "Non-Resident Release" for 2007-08 and will apply to attend on a "Non-Resident Release" in 2008-09):
- ✓ **Student is currently in Grade 3-6**
 - Complete "Nomination and Permission to Assess" form (available March 24, 2008)
 - Forms will be available at all Primary and Intermediate Schools, on the UPSD website, and at the District Office.
 - Submit "Nomination and Permission to Assess" form to your child's school or the UPSD Assessment Office (fax 566-5607) by April 25, 2008.
 - Student takes CogAT on May 3, 2008 at Narrows View Intermediate from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.
 - CogAT scores and program qualification information will be mailed home the week of June 2, 2008.

 - ✓ **Student is currently in Grade 7**
 - Complete "Nomination and Permission to Assess" form (available February 26, 2008)
 - Forms will be available at Drum, Narrows View, Curtis Junior High, on the UPSD website, and at the District Office.
 - Submit "Nomination and Permission to Assess" form to your child's school or the UPSD Assessment Office (fax 566-5607) by March 24, 2008.
 - Student takes CogAT on March 29, 2008 at Narrows View Intermediate from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.
 - CogAT scores and program qualification information will be mailed home the week of April 28, 2008.

Note: If applying for Non-Resident Release for 2008-09, the application process begins on March 3, 2008. Contact the District Office at 566-5600 if you have questions.

- Student currently resides in the University Place School District boundaries and attends a private school or home school (grades 2-7) must also:
- Submit (Slocumb-Payne) Creativity Scale completed by 2 teachers who have worked with the student most recently (send in with Nomination and Permission to Assess Form).
 - The Slocumb-Payne form is available on the UPSD website or through the UPSD Assessment Office.
